PE Update - Term 1 and Term 2

Key stage 2 PE during term 1 and 2 is focused on building team bonds and relationships by assigned roles in the PE teams that give the children responsibilities. They chose captains, coaches, equipment managers, point scorers and referees. All these roles were put to good use when playing Capture the Flag, T ball and Hockey.





The children also did a segment on Health and fitness which involved the pupils recording their personal results, striving to beat their best and understanding what fitness and exercise does to our bodies.

Helping your child manage their Anxiety

Children and young people can feel anxious about different things at different ages and different times. Anxiety becomes a problem for children and young people when it starts to get in the way of their everyday life.

Severe anxiety can harm children's mental and emotional wellbeing, affecting their self-esteem and confidence. We will think about how being neurodivergent (Autistic, ADHD or other) may impact how you experience anxiety and how to manage this.

These sessions are open to all parent carers in Somerset who have a child with additional needs and/or a disability. They will provide you information about anxiety. We will help you to identify the signs to look out for and strategies you can use to support your child.
