These improvements are aimed at creating warm, safe, and watertight learning environments for the children of the Croscombe Community.

This work represents a vital investment in the future of our children and will help us to provide a safe and supportive learning environment for the next generation. It reflects our ongoing commitment to offering the best possible education and opportunities for all.

We understand that projects of this nature can cause temporary disruption, particularly with increased building traffic in the area. The scaffolding for the project is due to be erected starting Monday, 16 June, and the scaffolding team estimates that these works will take approximately one week to complete. The site at Croscombe School is particularly challenging in terms of access and parking, so we greatly appreciate your patience as this work is carried out. Please be assured that every effort will be made to minimise disruption and manage all works in a safe and respectful manner. Deliveries and construction activity will be carefully scheduled and monitored to limit their impact on the local community.
